Advanced Camps Grades 9-12 Sunday Jan. 6th Hitting: 2-4pm Pitching: 5-7pm The hitting clinic will provide two hours of drills, demonstrations, lectures, and measurables regarding hitting fundamentals, bunting, situational hitting, and mental training for High School athletes. Each hitter will learn important aspects of the offensive part of the game to compete at a high level. The pitching clinic will focus on mechanics and pitch development for players in High School. Each pitcher will learn drills specifically for their age/ability level in the areas of body position, spin, accuracy and power.

Fundamental Camps Grades 4-8 Sunday Jan. 13th Hitting: 9-11am Defense: 12-2pm Pitching: 2-4pm

The hitting, defensive, and pitching clinics are intended for youth looking to gain basic knowledge in technique, mechanics, body awareness, and approach in each respective area of the game. All aspects of the offensive part of the game will be covered in respects to hitting, bunting, and mental approach. Defensively, participants will learn proper throwing mechanics, footwork, angles, range, and glove work for both infield and outfield positions. Pitchers will gain knowledge on the basic fundamentals regarding body movements, mechanics, strength, accuracy, and velocity. Each pitcher will learn drills specifically designed for their age/ability level.

Elite Beaver Camp Grades 9-12 Sunday Feb. 10th 10am-1pm The Elite Beaver Camp is for prospects that will be a total skills camp involving all areas of the game. After the camp, campers are encouraged to stay for a campus tour and listen to coaches and staff discuss opportunities at the next level for all divisions and an NCAA talk that includes a Q & A session. The skill instructions include; Outfield defense: proper angles, fielding, footwork, throwing, positioning and catching. Infield defense: proper fielding techniques, footwork, glovework, transfers, throwing, positioning and strategy. Hitting: mechanics and technique regarding leg drive, hand path, barrel path, contact points, power, vision training and mental approach. Pitching: basic mechanics with leg drive, power line, body awareness and snaps/spins. Catching: basic mechanics with receiving, framing, blocking, throw downs and battery relationship.
